Newspaper Information – Follow-up Lesson after visit day

JA BizTown does not have a student newspaper produced during the visit day, so it was suggested that producing a paper after the visit day would be a good follow-up tool for debriefing the experience. To aid in producing a paper, we have included a newspaper layout template.

You can use this template by printing out the layout and using it for a guide. The students write out their articles and ads or print them off a computer then cut them out. Lay a piece of paper over the template and lay the cut out articles on the top sheet. When the layout is done, tape the articles and adds down. Not much tape is needed. Copy the pages and collate. You may also use a template such as the one provided for newsletters in Microsoft Word.

Newspaper Writing Topics for Students:

What did you like best about your job at JA BizTown?

How was customer service demonstrated in your business?

Describe what your business sold & if your business provided a good or a service.

If you could add a shop to JA BizTown, what type of shop would you add?

What was the most challenging part of your job at JA BizTown?

What surprised you during your visit day?

Describe your job responsibilities and tasks for your specific position.
